**COMPENSATION FOR OCCUPATIONAL INJURIES AND DISEASES ACT,
1993 (ACT No. 130 OF 1993), AS AMENDED**

**TO INCREASE THE MONTHLY PENSIONS OF INJURED EMPLOYEES AND
DEPENDANTS IN CASE OF DEATH (WIDOWS/WIDOWERS) WHO ARE
CURRENTLY RECEIVING A MONTHLY PENSION OF LESS THAN R1 000.00
PER MONTH, TO A MINIMUM PENSION OF R1 000.00 PER MONTH.**

Under section 57(1) of the Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act, 1993 (Act No 130 of 1993), I, Mildred Nelisiwe Oliphant, Minister of Labour, hereby prescribe a minimum level of pension on Compensation fund with immediate effect to the following beneficiaries:

Monthly pensions of injured employees, irrespective of their level of disablement, currently receiving a monthly pension of less than a R1 000.00 per month to a minimum amount of R1 000.00 per month.

Monthly pension of dependants (widows/widowers) currently receiving less than R1 000.00 per month to a minimum of R1 000.00 per month.

Pensioners or dependants who commuted a portion of their pensions should not be eligible, and their pensions should not be adjusted as above.
